FAQ for Rides (provided by Skelly Amusements)

Q: Do adults need to have a wristband or tickets if accompanying a child on rides?

A: Per the amusement company, all riders need wristbands or tickets. There are only the following exclusions when a parent accompanying a child onto a ride will not need a wristband or tickets: The Slide, The Merry-Go-Round, The Dizzy Dragons, The Fire Academy and The Happy Swing. Please note that adults riding alone must have tickets. Also, adults accompanying children whose height does not require an adult must have tickets to ride. Example - Riders who are 36" to 42" must be accompanied by an adult on the Fire Academy. Adults accompanying children who are above 42" must have a ticket to ride.

Q: Are there height requirements for the rides?

A: Yes, all ride and height requirements will be posted at each ticket booth as well as each ride. If your child is told he/she doesn't meet the requirement, the ride operator must ask the child to step out of the line. You may bring your child to Skelly's Amusements management at the Cotton Candy Trailer to get more accurately measured and the child will be given proof of verified height along with permission to ride.

Q: How many tickets are required for each ride?

A: Each ride requires 1 to 3 tickets. The required tickets will be posted on each ride. The exception is Gravity Storm, which is cash only.

Q: What form of payment can be used for amusements?

A: Ticket booths will accept cash, credit cards, debit cards, Apple Pay and all tap to pay options.
